This was done to reduce the lengthy process for all to autograph the same documents, and to retain solidarity and accordance with one another and provide at least two (2) witnesses.

We are aware of confusion regarding an initiative set forth by The Peacekeeping Task Force (PKTF) as an effort to expand outreach and drive new growth for State Assemblies. This confusion stemmed from individual(s) within and outside of the PKTF. This initiative, as what appears to be part of the Resurgence Project, has attempted to establish a “model county assembly” on Alabama, which involves public meetings and tours across the State, as a way to “grow State and County Assemblies together.”

This idea may work in certain scenarios such as when a State has enough members to tackle this kind of project without compromising the organizing and standing of The State Assembly. This could be a great outreach effort and a means to ensure that County Assemblies are somewhat established and ready to begin functioning once The State Assembly is organized and standing. In fact, Anna recently confirmed on a webinar that this initiative was meant to provide a template for future Counties and to drive new growth to The State Assemblies. However, it also creates a loophole for infiltration and for disgruntled members to break away from The State Assembly and attempt to gain control of its functions. In Alabama’s case, it has led to just that kind of situation.

There are members within this “model county assembly” who have been removed from their prior positions for The State Assembly due to breach of trust and others who have been removed from The State Assembly altogether for long-term disruption. At this time, these members include:
